Tickets are on sale for the world's largest roller derby tournament, The Great Southern Slam (TGSS), at the Adelaide Showground on Saturday, 11 June to Monday 13 June.

Hosted again by Adelaide Roller Derby, the event will bring together 45+ leagues from across Australia and New Zealand who will compete in two divisions:

- Saturday, Division 1 & 2 Tournaments
- Sunday, Division 1 & 2 Tournaments and Quarter Finals
- Monday, Division 1 & 2 Semi Finals and Grand Finals

If you want the full three-day experience, you can purchase a pre-sale weekend pass from Oztix via <u>www.oztix.com.au</u>, \$60 + booking fee. Alternatively, day passes can be purchased at the door; \$20 for Saturday and Sunday and; \$30 for the Finals on Monday.
